



**Gina Miller invited to provide evidence to French Senate's Working Group on Brexit  
on Thursday 17 September 2019**

January 16 2019 (London, UK) – Gina Miller, the transparency campaigner, businesswoman, Founder of [endthechaos.co.uk](http://endthechaos.co.uk), and whose court case enabled votes in Parliament on Brexit, will tomorrow (January 17 2019) give evidence to the French Senate's Working Group on the Withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the European Union (Groupe de suivi sur le Brexit) in Paris, at the Palais du Luxembourg.

At the invitation of the Committee's co-chair, Sénateur Jean Bizet, Mrs Miller has been asked to provide her analysis of the current state of affairs in the UK, in relation to Brexit, and to discuss the fallout following the collapse of the Prime Minister's deal last night. She will be providing evidence based on her campaign's grassroots research and engagement with the public, both leavers and remainers, as well as conversations with the leading political actors on all sides in this process.

Tomorrow's session will be the latest in a series of evidence sessions held by the Senate Working Group and will focus on the possible options now available to the UK Government, as well as likely responses from France and the EU.

Mrs Miller said: "In the face of the historic and humiliating collapse of the Prime Minister's deal in the Commons last night, the world has been left wondering, 'what next?' Clearly, time is fast running out and we can't just keep doing the same thing over and over again expecting the result to be any different. That, as we all know, is how Einstein defined insanity.

"As the deadline on March 29 draws alarmingly close, all sides need to agree a sensible way to move forward. I am a firm believer that if we are to end the continuing and damaging uncertainty being felt both at home and on the continent, we must maintain an open dialogue with our European neighbours to examine all options to secure the best possible outcome for the British people. I am happy to share whatever I have learnt with all parties at this crucial moment and am looking forward to discussing possible ways forward with Senator Bizet and his colleagues".
